ARCHITECTURE

The REAKTOR is structured into three halls of different sizes, each built during distinct architectural periods, along with adjoining side wings. The Great Hall showcases late classicist, three-aisled splendor, while the former Strauss-Lanner Hall, now a cinema, exudes early historicist charm with an intimate, chamber music-like atmosphere. The late historicist library, formerly known as the fresco-rich Jägerzimmer, is characterized by Bauhaus-like simplicity. With its timeless qualities, the versatile architecture of this former event establishment continues to offer ideal settings for various occasions, such as conferences, black-tie ceremonies, workshops, seminars, award ceremonies, fashion shows, product presentations, photo and film shoots, and much more.

LETTING

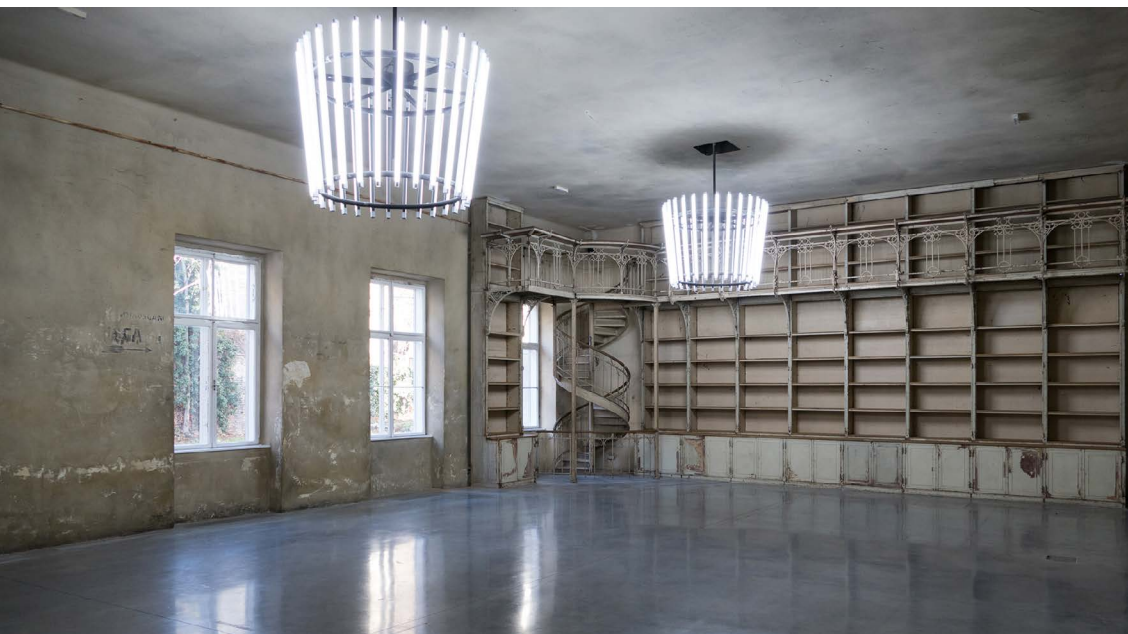
REAKTOR's three interconnecting halls, which can be closed off from each other, along with the adjoining rooms, provide a modern infrastructure covering a total area of 1,200 m². The sensitive refurbishment has preserved the time shaped character while creating functional spaces for contemporary events. The facility also houses a professional cinema equipped with state-of-the-art industry technology, suitable for presentations. The REAKTOR is wheelchair accessible, with all halls and the delivery area at ground level. Each auditorium is equipped with a 63A power connection.

SOUND EMISSIONS

Due to its distinctive architectural features and its location within a residential area, it is essential to give careful consideration to noise emissions during events. Consequently, events scheduled after 22:00 are limited to two of the halls. Clubbing or events featuring amplified electronic music and other high noise levels are not permissible at the REAKTOR. Background music may be permitted in consultation with the REAKTOR staff.

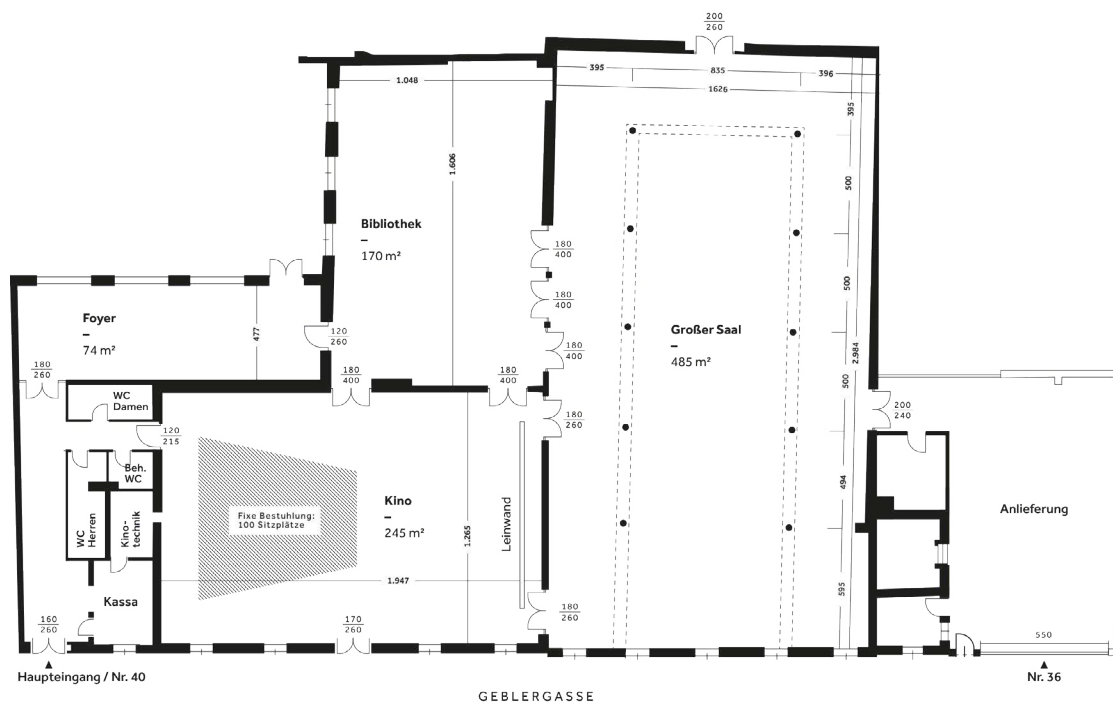

Location & accessibility

- The REAKTOR is located on the boundary with Vienna's Ottakring district, a mere five minutes' walk from the vibrant Yppenplatz.
- It is served by tram lines Nos. 1, 43, 44 and the U-Bahn underground line No. 6, offering excellent connections to the city's public transport infrastructure.
- There is a Contipark underground car park in the immediate vicinity, on Jörgerstrasse/Syringasse.
- A parking area some 6 x 12 m in size is available for deliveries and drop-offs.



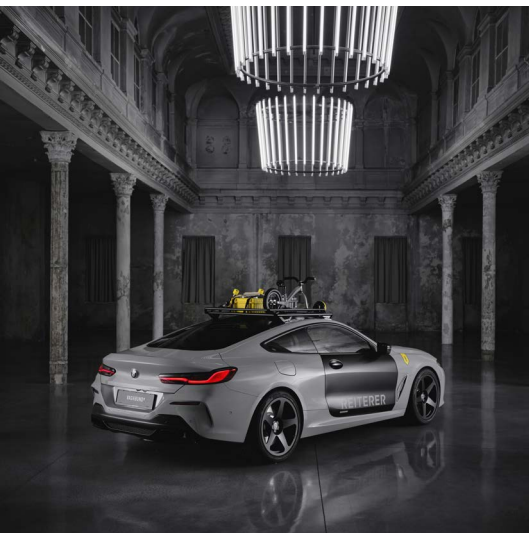
